What have we been learning? #beingstrategic

We've had a terrific week twenty! Here are some highlights in each subject area:

Reading: This week we continued using **text features** to help us locate information. We practiced explicitly referring back to the text to determine the main idea and supporting details. *Ask your child to share a unique adaptation their frog uses to survive.

Writing: This week we used the information we gained about our frog to draft, revise, and edit **informational essays** about our frogs unique adaptations. We wrote and revised an introduction, two body paragraphs, and conclusion. *Ask your child to share the difference between simple, compound, and complex sentences.

Math: This week we explored pictographs and bar graphs and used them to represent data. We also practiced using the data to ask and answer questions. *Ask your child to share why it is so important to look at the key in a pictograph.

Science & Social Studies: This week we began our **economics unit** by exploring goods and services, as well as natural, human, and capital resources. *Ask your child to share what natural resources the boy found in <u>The Giving Tree</u>.
