What have we been learning? #beingstrategic

We've had a terrific week thirteen! Here are some highlights in each subject area:

Reading: This week we continued to explore **pourquoi tales** and the narrative framework (beginning: introduce characters and situation; *middle*: introduce problem and response; *end*: wraps up problem and tells point of story). We also brainstormed a whole list of class 'Why' ideas. *Ask your child to share which Why idea they chose for their story.

Writing: This week we continued to explore the narrative framework by writing our own pourquoi tale! After writing rough drafts, we revised and edited on our own and also with a partner. *Ask your child to share details about their story.

Math: While practicing our multiplication and division facts, we explored **equality** and determining unknown **variables** in equations. *Ask your child to share the 12's song for remembering multiples of 12.

Science & Social Studies: This week we started learning all about earth, moon, and sun systems with Ms. Ferneyhough. We explored how far objects in our solar system are from the sun. *Ask your child to share about the outdoor 'experiment' they did with Ms. F.
