What have we been learning? #beingstrategic

We've had a super week sixteen! Here are some highlights in each subject area:

Reading: This week we continued using text features to help us locate information. We also practiced explicitly referring back to the text to determine the gist and meaning of unfamiliar vocabulary. *Ask your child to share something they learned about water holding frog or poison dart frog.

Writing: This week we used the information we gained about amphibians and reptiles to draft, revise, and edit informational paragraphs with a topic sentence and supporting details. *Ask your child to share a detail about why poison dart frogs are so colorful.

Math: This week we explored multiplying by tens and using exacts and estimates when solving multi-step word problems. Be sure to practice fact fluency at home! *Ask your child to share how they would go about solving 6 x 70.

Science & Social Studies: This week we continued learning more about the five themes of geography with Ms. Hazelarove. *Ask your child to share the difference between longitude and latitude.
