What have we been learning? #beingstrategic

We've had a terrific week twenty-three! Here are some highlights in each subject area:

Reading: This week we continued our focus on the literary classic, Peter Pan. The Darling children have finally made it to Neverland, and have started to encounter some wonders and danaers on the island. **Ask your child how Wendy's & Tinker Bell's character traits are similar and different!

Writing: This week we practiced using information from Peter Pan to take detailed **notes** about each chapter. **Ask your child to share how each chapter has built upon the previous one.

Math: This week we continued to explore area and perimeter of rectangles and rectilinear shapes. We even practiced finding the area and perimeter of the same shape. **Ask your child to share how they would find the area of a 4×9 rectangle.

Science & Social Studies: This week we continued our **economics unit** by exploring entrepreneurs and how location impacts supply and demand. *Ask your child to share the (three regions of NC and different goods produced in each one.
