What have we been learning? #beingstrategic

We've had a terrific week twenty-five! Here are some highlights in each subject area:

Reading: This week we continued our focus on the **literary classic**, *Peter Pan*, and added an additional story, *Peter Pan in Kensington Gardens*. We are becoming experts at determining similarities and differences between the two texts. **Ask your child to share one way the two stories are alike and different.

Writing: This week we continued to practice using information from *Peter Pan* to take detailed **notes** about each chapter. **Ask your child to share how each chapter has built upon the previous one.

Math: This week we wrapped up our area and perimeter unit. We loved designing our dream room! **Ask your child to share what they included in their room.

Science & Social Studies: This week started

learning all about landforms with Ms. Hazelgrove. *Ask your child to share a specific landform and how they would describe it.

Positivity Project: This week we focused on the character strength **social intelligence** (being aware of other people's thoughts and feelings). Be sure to ask your child how they can use facial expressions and body language to be more aware of how others are feeling. #otherpeoplematter
