What have we been learning? #beingstrategic

We've had a terrific week twenty-nine! Here are some highlights in each subject area:

Reading & Writing: This week we continued to explore fantasy elements in different stories (Good News, Bad News; Where the Wild Things Are). We used our graphic organizers to draft and revise/edit our own fantasy story. We also practiced adding dialogue, and wrote final copies! **Ask your child to share about the story they created.

Math: This week we continued our focus on fractions. We practiced naming fractions, finding equivalent fractions, and even looked at mixed numbers and improper fractions. **Ask your child to share what 4/1 would stand for.

Science & Social Studies: This week started learning all about plants with Ms. Ferneyhough. We dissected a seed and even planted seeds.
