What have we been learning? #beingstrategic

We've had a terrific week thirty-three! Here are some highlights in each subject area:

Reading & Writing: This week we continued our unit focused on freshwater around the world. We explored many sections of One Well, and discussed topics like: demands on the well, access to freshwater, and population growth. We practiced determining the meaning of unknown words based on context clues, figuring out the main idea/ supporting details, and comparing/contrasting two texts. **Ask your child to share the difference between a noun, verb, adjective, and adverb.

Math: This week we wrapped up our focus on **comparing fractions**. We are really becoming experts at comparing fractions just by taking a closer look at the numerator and denominator. **Ask your child to share about Freckle and Prodigy!

Science & Social Studies: This week we worked on our class **Kindness Challenge** in small groups. **Ask your child to share what specific kindness group they are in!
