# What have we been learning? \#beingstrategic 

We've had a fantastic fourth week! Here are some highlights in each subject area:

Reading: This week we continued to explore Nasreen's Secret School, and examined how the main characters overcame challenges. We worked on identifying the gist (what the story was mostly about) and determining the lesson/message/moral. We also worked to determine the meaning of important text specific vocabulary. *Ask your child to share the lesson/message/moral of Nasreen's Secret School.
Writing: This week we practiced creating short written responses with specific details from the text to support our ideas. *Ask your child to share how they write constructed responses.
Math: This week we reviewed addition, subtraction, and rounding strategies . *Ask your child to share how they would round a number to the nearest ten or hundred.
Science \& Social Studies: This week we took a closer look at the structure and function of the local government and how it meets the needs of its citizens. *Ask your child to share odd laws and examples of laws that have changed over time.
